Tasks to Prevent the Spread of Covid-19 during Courses at UZH

Using this fact sheet, event organizers are required to ensure that the guidelines for avoiding Covid-19 transmissions are observed. If required, they must point out the applicable rules to participants either at the start or during the event. Organizers may ask students who do not comply with the rules to leave the venue, or may stop the event if necessary.

Organization, Information and Ventilation	Implemented
Have people with obvious symptoms of Covid-19 ¹ been denied participation in the event and sent home? Common symptoms include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Symptoms of acute respiratory illness (sore throat, (dry) coughing, shortness of breath, chest pain) – Fever – Sudden loss of smell and/or taste 	<input type="checkbox"/> Yes <input type="checkbox"/> No
Have participants been informed that only people with a valid Covid certificate may attend the event? Teaching staff are not responsible for carrying out checks, but may do so if they believe it is necessary.	<input type="checkbox"/> Yes <input type="checkbox"/> No

Have all participants been informed that wearing a mask ² is strongly recommended? The following people are exempt from this recommendation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – People who have a certificate from a doctor or psychotherapist that exempts them from having to wear a mask. Social Distancing and Occupancy in Teaching Rooms (e.g. Lecture Halls, Seminar Rooms)	Implemented
