# Choosing Courses: Good to Know

- You are free to choose any courses offered by the faculty, but...
- please book courses corresponding to your level of studies only (if absolutely necessary: **max. two higher level courses**)
- **You may book a maximum of two courses at ETH,** amounting to no more than one third of your overall ECTS credits
- Certain **seminars** offer a limited number of places  
→ a second application at the chair may be required  
→ check online course catalogue and website of professor



## Booking Courses

- Booking: Official registration for examinations
- Access: Student Portal ([link](#))
- Deadlines: Booking and cancellation starting on **17 January 2024** ending on **12 March 2024, midnight**

→ Every booked course will appear on your Transcript of Records even if you do not attend or write the exam (“failed attempt”)

## Booking Courses: How to Avoid Pitfalls

- Do read the course description and make sure you comply with the requirements
- Book only courses on the appropriate level of studies
- Do not book more than 20-30 ECTS credits per semester
- Remember to cancel courses you do not want to attend
- Ask your Buddy all the nasty questions

# Hand in Petition with Doctor's Attestation

- If you cannot take an examination due to an illness or accident, you must request to withdraw from the related module in the Student Portal (“My Requests” tile).
- The request must be submitted no later than five business days after the examination date.
- All modules with examinations taking place during the duration of your inability to work will be canceled.

- Individual repeat examinations for individual students are not permitted.



# Transcript of Records

- All students at UZH receive their transcripts of records in PDF format (in English and/or German). It lists all passed and failed modules, including ETH courses.
- **It will be available for DOWLOAD IN THE STUDENT PORTAL on the Friday of calendar week 38 (Sept. 20, 2024)**
- You can access the student portal up to four months after the end of the semester. If you need a transcript at a later point in time, please use the contact form provided by the Student Services website ([link](#)).



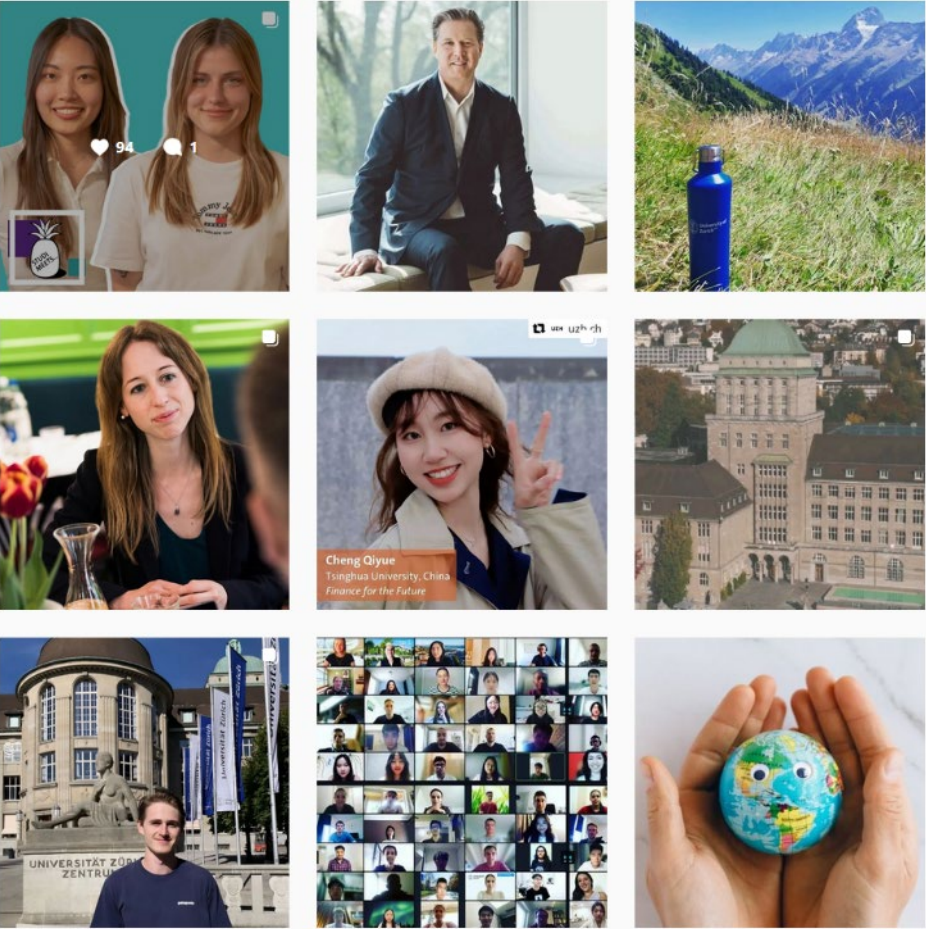

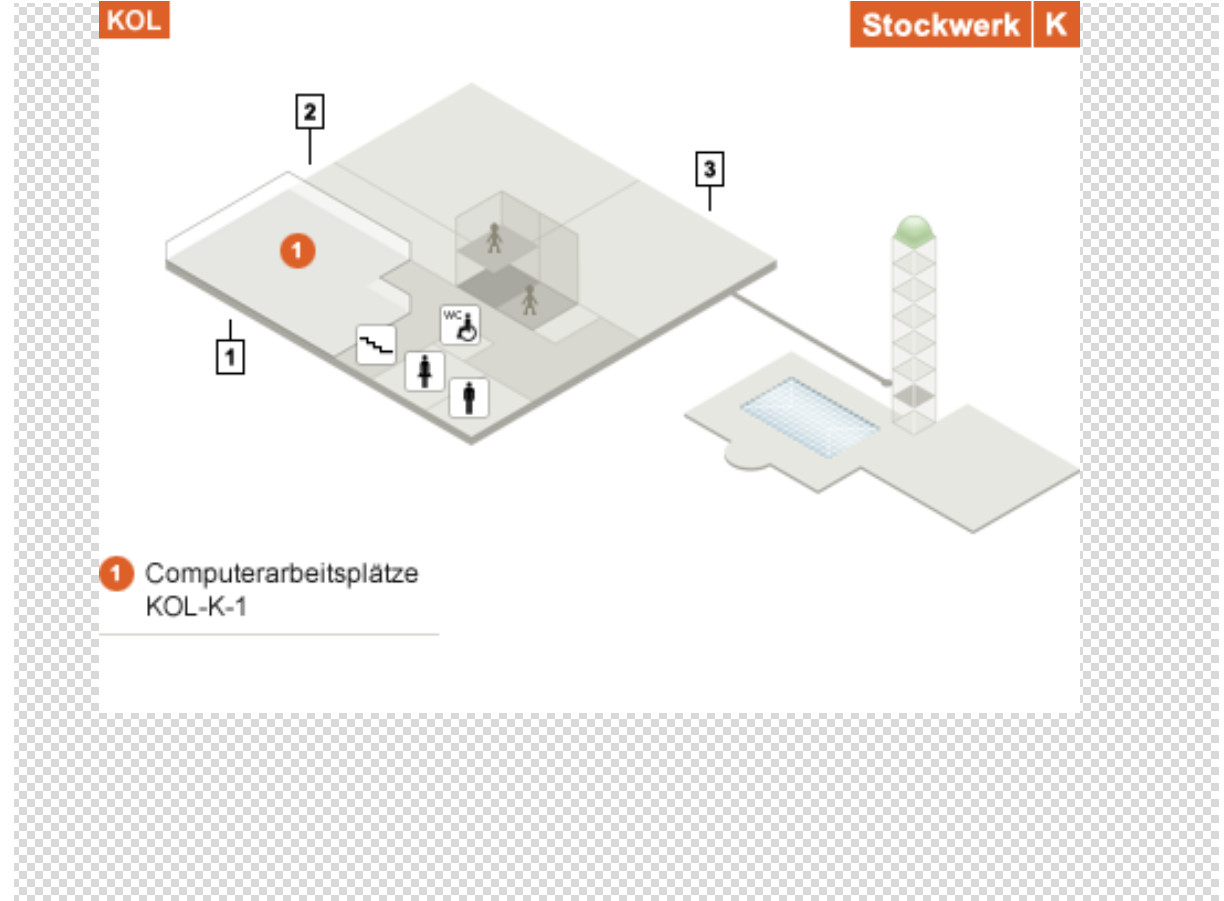
