



Allocation to a Representative Body

University Act §19 para. 2 stipulates that the co-determination rights may only be exercised via a single representative body. Automatic allocation to a representative body is based on the following principles:


Enrolled Students (Bachelor's, Master's, Teaching Diploma for Upper Secondary Education)

Students may only belong to the Student Representative Body.

- Persons employed at UZH under public law
- Persons employed at UZH under private law
- Teaching staff at UZH who are remunerated according to a posting agreement

According to their activity at UZH, they belong to one of the other three representative bodies. Persons, who could belong to more than one representative body will be allocated in this order:

Junior Researchers priority over Senior Researchers and Teaching Staff priority over Administrative and technical Staff (ATP)
