### Event Requirements

All participants must have a valid Covid certificate as well as an ID card. The event organizer must check this information for all participants.

#### **The following provisions apply for the event:**

- Organizers must define and mark off an event perimeter in which masks do not have to be worn.
- Entry must be restricted to participants with a valid Covid certificate only. Exceptions are made for organizational staff (e.g. cleaners, tech support, security staff, assistants, etc.). These staff must either all have a valid Covid certificate or must all wear masks.
- Outside the event perimeter, all participants must wear masks when moving around the publicly accessible areas of UZH.
