General Conditions of Transport of the UZH Transport Service

- We transport your goods within the city limits of Zurich and to sites on Schlieren Campus.
- Transports must be requested at least 48 hours in advance by filling out the relevant transport order form online <https://www.staff.uzh.ch/en/arbeitsplatz/post-transport/queter-transportieren/uzh-transportdienst.html>. We will confirm the receipt of your transport request by email. A surcharge of CHF 100 applies to additional transport runs and express transports (requests made less than 48 hours in advance). Should additional transport runs become necessary (e.g. as a result of missing nitrogen containers), these journeys will be charged at a standard amount of CHF 100.
- Max. load: 850kg
- Max. measurements: Length 330cm, width 130 cm, height 180cm
- A declaration of clearance <https://www.staff.uzh.ch/en/arbeitsplatz/reinigung-entsorgung/entsorgung-geraet/unbedenklichkeitserklaerung.html> must be filled in for goods which stem from a biology laboratory with a biosafety level of 2 or higher, or from a chemical or isotope laboratory, or which could be contaminated with biological, chemical or radioactive substances.
- The goods to be transported must include the name of the sender as well as the delivery address.
- The goods to be transported must be ready for pick-up at the entrance of the building (at Irchel Campus at the Receipt of Goods office).
- Transport of heavily contaminated goods may be refused by the driver of the Transport Service.
- Goods will be delivered to the entrance of the building. The relevant facility management office is responsible for distribution within the building.
- Transports from ETH Zurich to UZH are only carried out by the ETH Zurich transport service.
- By commissioning the UZH Transport Service, you agree to these General Conditions of Transport.
