

马来西亚华人作家李忆莙的《遗梦之北》获《亚洲周刊》评选为2012年度十大中文小说。小说以马来西亚一个小镇为背景,展现移民到南洋的华人生活,保留了许多民间信仰和世俗的生活实践。它以叶氏家族的几代女性的命运为主线,描述她们的心灵世界和人生最寻常的悲欢离合,以及生命更深层处的精神世界。此文探索女性命运在多神崇拜和宿命观念下所受到的冲击,也可以说是一部神秘又实在的南洋女性心灵史。
