Certificate Requirement for On-Site Exams at UZH: Checklist

Certificates are required for the 2021 Fall Semester examinations at UZH. Therefore, only students with a valid Covid certificate, a valid Covid certificate or a test certificate from ETH or PHZH are admitted to on-site exams. The UZH Covidpass is no longer issued. Those tested will receive an official Covid certificate.

The certificate and photo ID (identity card, passport, student ID card) of every person in attendance must be checked at the door of the exam hall.

Exceptions

Those who cannot get vaccinated or tested for medical reasons may show a medical certificate. In this case, it must be checked that the certificate confirms that the person concerned cannot be vaccinated or tested. In addition, it must be checked whether the certificate actually belongs to the person presenting it by comparing it with a photo ID.

Checking the official Covid certificates

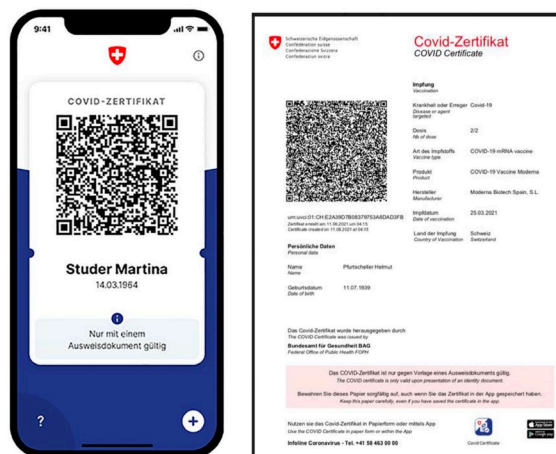
To enable the authenticity and validity of a digital Covid certificate to be checked, a **Covid Certificate Check** app is provided by the federal government. The QR code on the certificate (print-out, image or in the Covid Certificate app) must be scanned using the Covid Certificate Check app. The QR code, as long as it is correct and compatible, contains the necessary information such as the validity of the certificate. The Covid Certificate Check app in turn contains a verification key which verifies that the data stored in the QR code has not been tampered with.

- The Covid Certificate Check app is available free of charge in the [Apple App Store](#), the [Google Play Store](#) and the [Huawei AppGallery](#).
- Install the Covid Certificate Check app on a mobile phone or tablet (e.g. iPad) and agree to camera use through the app.

Covid certificates are to be checked using the Covid Certificate Check app only. Manual scrolling, checking the certificate simply by looking at it, or using the refresh button in the student's Covid Certificate app is not permitted. The refresh button is only meant for the owner of the certificate to see if it is still valid.

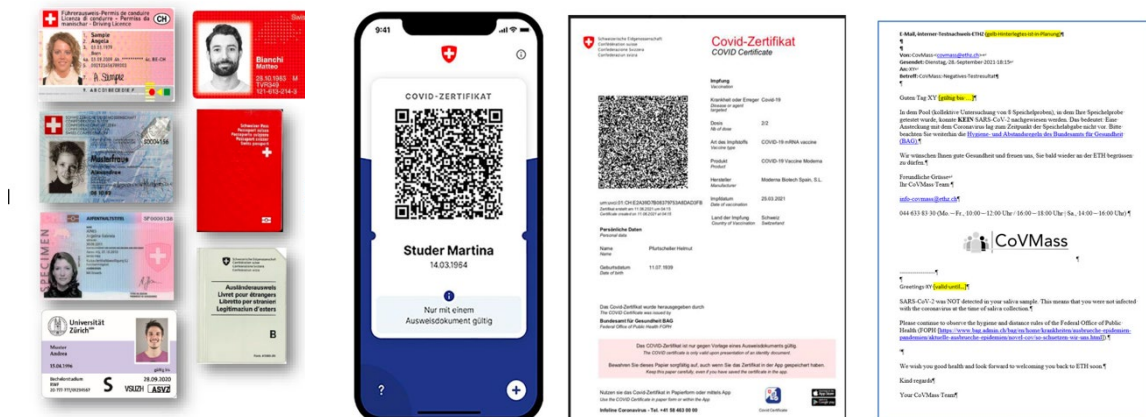

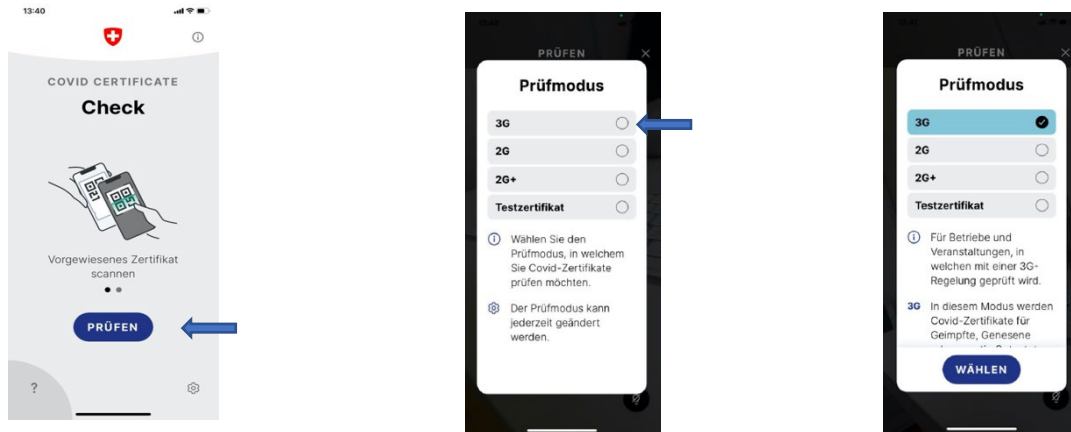
Supporting documents that must be presented:

- Identification document with photo (for example passport, identity card, driver's license, residence permit, student ID, SwissPass) **AND**
- QR code of a digital Covid Certificate (on paper, as an image/photo or the Covid Certificate app)
- **OR** ETH/PHZH test certificate (see above)

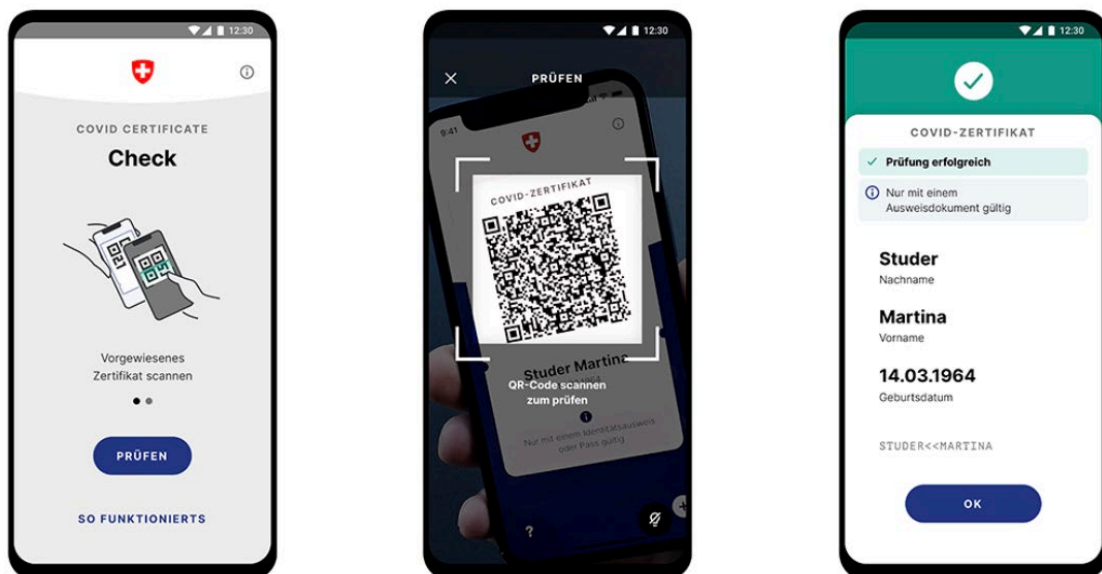


Other types of evidence cannot be accepted.

The certificate check is carried out in 3G check mode. This is to be selected in the app as follows:



If the certificate is valid, the upper part of the display in the check app turns green. If it is invalid, the display turns red. Compare the name and date of birth on the certificate with the photo ID.



The UZH Covid Pass and the ETH and PHZH test certificates cannot be scanned.
