

Guest Lecture Dr. Pablo Blitstein (Heidelberg University)

Pablo Blitstein studied ancient Greek and Roman Literature and Philosophy at the University of Buenos Aires and Chinese history at the Institut National des Langues et Civilisations Orientales (Paris), where he completed his Ph.D. dissertation in early medieval Chinese history. He has also conducted research at the National Taiwan University and Peking University. He is co-founder and co-organizer of the Chinese history section of the Research Centre on the Slavic and Chinese Worlds (CEMECH) at the University of San Martín (Argentina). His research interests are global and conceptual history, with a special focus on the history of writing and political institutions.
