### Membership Guidelines

#### Requirements for membership

Group leaders addressing evolutionary questions at the organismal, molecular and/or conceptual level at the University of Zurich can apply for membership at the URPP Evolution in Action.

Applications are subject to approval by the URPP Evolution in Action Steering Committee. Applications should be submitted to the coordination office of the URPP Evolution in Action.

They should include:

- A CV and application letter of the applicant describing the motivation for joining the URPP Evolution in Action, how the ongoing research fits the goals of the URPP Evolution in Action, and what is the foreseen contribution to the URPP Evolution in Action.
- a supporting letter of a member of the URPP Evolution in Action.

Applicants will be informed about the Steering Committee's decision within 1 month.

#### Duties and rights of URPP Evolution in Action members

Members:

- must contribute to the annual report of the URPP Evolution in Action
- are expected to contribute to the duties and activities (such as public outreach activities) of the URPP Evolution in Action
- are expected to participate in the annual retreat and seminars of the URPP Evolution in Action
- are expected to contribute to the education of young scientists in the field of evolution
- must provide and regularly update a description of their research activities on the URPP Evolution in Action website
- must acknowledge the URPP Evolution in Action in all publications arising from projects financed by the URPP Evolution in Action
- must list all publications arising from projects financed by the URPP Evolution in Action in the URPP Evolution in Action section in ZORA (Zurich Open Repository and Archive)
- may apply for funding through the URPP Evolution in Action, when the URPP Evolution in Action advertises a call for proposals
- may apply for reimbursement of costs of external speakers participating in the seminar program of the URPP Evolution in Action
- may sponsor new members of the URPP Evolution in Action
- may propose teaching courses which can be partially or completely financed by the URPP Evolution in Action.
