

Swiss Sport Integrity Anti-Doping

Multiple functions:

- National Anti-Doping Agency
 - Art. 19 (2) SpoPA: «to take measures against doping» and «This agency issues the required rulings».
 - Administrative law function: seizing and destroying doping products.
 - Criminal law function: support to the authorities.
- National Anti-Doping Organization (NADO)
 - Adopting and implementing anti-doping rules
 - Collecting samples
 - Conducting investigations
 - Conducting result management



2. Sport Promotion Act

Sport Promotion Act Prosecution

Art. 23

- ¹ The cantons are responsible for prosecution. The cantonal prosecution authorities may involve the anti-doping agency as established under Article 19 (...) in any investigations.
- ² If substances or methods under Article 19 paragraph 3 are identified in a doping control, the agency carrying out the control shall inform the prosecution authorities responsible and send them all the pertinent documents.
- ³ The anti-doping agency established under Article 19 has the following **party rights** as defined in Article 104 paragraph 2 of the Criminal Procedure Code:
 - a. to file an appeal against discontinuation and no proceedings orders;
 - b. to file an objection to summary penalty orders;
 - c. to file an appeal and accessory appeal against sentence against judgments.



Sport Promotion Act Information

Art. 24

The responsible prosecution and judicial authorities shall inform the anti-doping agency established under Article 19 of any criminal proceedings begun as a result of an infringement under Article 22, and also of its rulings. The Federal Council establishes what information shall be communicated.

Art. 78 SpoPO

¹ The responsible prosecution and judicial authorities responsible for violations of Art. 22 SpoPA shall disclose the following information to the anti-doping agency:


- f. the interrogation protocols;
- h. the decisions of the law enforcement and judicial authorities (...);





4. Practical Examples

Practical Examples Art. 23 (2) – SSI to prosecutor: difficulties in cooperation

- Laboratory reports an adverse analytical finding (AAF) involving boldenone, a steroid (20 February).
- Boldenone is listed in the annexe of the SpoPO as a prohibited substance.
- SSI informs the prosecution authorities resonsible (3 March):

Contrôle antidopage positif - Loi sur l'encouragement du sport

Monsieur le procureur,

Mis à part le résultat d'analyse précité, Antidoping Suisse ne possède pas d'informations indiquant des infractions contre l'art. 22 de la Loi fédérale sur l'encouragement du sport et de l'activité physique (LESp). Conformément à l'art. 23 al. 2 LESp, vous trouverez tout de même une copie des deux principales pièces de notre dossier ci-joint.

Par la présente, Antidoping Suisse vous prie de bien vouloir nous faire savoir si vous souhaitez que nous continuions à suspendre la prise de contact avec Monsieur disciplinaire à son encontre. En outre, en vertu de l'art. 24 LESp, nous nous permettons de vous demander de bien vouloir, le moment venu, nous informer des éventuelles poursuites engagées ainsi que des décisions prises.

Practical Examples Art. 23 (2) – SSI to prosecutor: difficulties in cooperation

- Email SSI to prosecutor (9 May).
- Email SSI to prosecutor (30 May).
- Email prosecutor to SSI (31 May): approval to beginn the results management process.
 - three months after our information.
- We received interrogation protocol / information exchange with prosecutor.
- Results Management: notification of the athlete (25 June).

Practical Examples First athlete convicted under the SpoPA

Aargauer Zeitung, 4 August 2020:

STRAFBEFEHL

Erstes Schweizer Dopingurteil gegen Veloprofi Pirmin Lang schafft neue Fragen

Der 2017 zurückgetretene Radrennfahrer Pirmin Lang wird als erster Elitesportler aufgrund des Schweizer Sportförderungsgesetzes strafrechtlich belangt. Er wollte dem Hauptangeklagten der «Operation Aderlass» illegales Material liefern.

Practical Examples First athlete convicted under the SpoPA

- Case originates from the Operation Aderlass.
- Fedpol and Investigations Department SII (then Antidoping Switzerland).
- Canton of Aargau: police and prosecutor.
- Interrogations were held.
- Convicted by the prosecutor by order of punishment (Strafbefehl):
 - Conditional fine of 500 francs
 - Fine of 100 francs
 - Costs of the proceedings
