MARK J. PINDER (Open University) | "Conceptual Engineering, Methods, and Methodologies"

In this talk, I draw a distinction between methods and methodologies, arguing that it is an important distinction for supporters of conceptual engineering. For example, the distinction can help us to meet our argumentative burden, to keep clear on 'the contours of methodological space', and to defuse 'change of subject' objections. I close with some possible desiderata for a conceptual engineering methodology, and some thoughts on how we might meet them.
